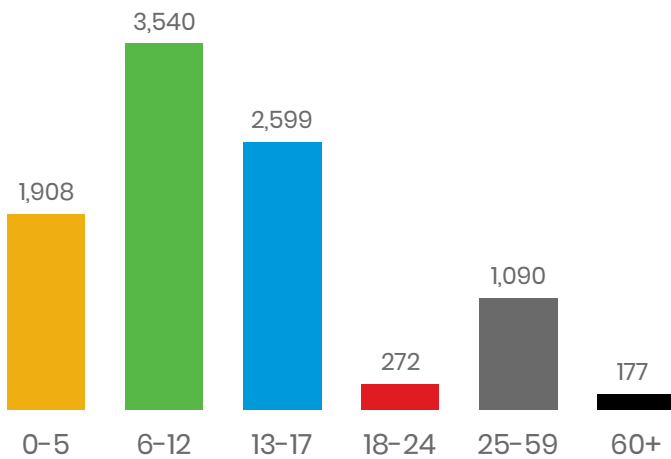
Children and their non-offending family members were served in-person at DCAC.



Our typical child is a 9-year-old girl who was sexually abused by someone she knows and trusts.

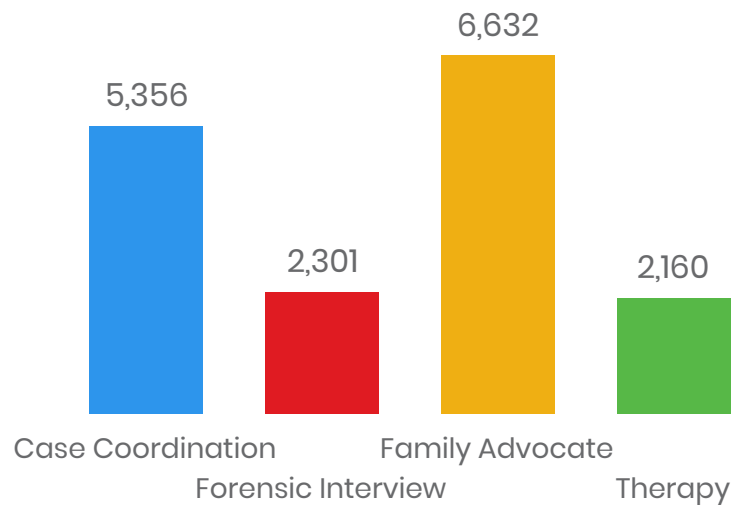
AGE OF CLIENT

includes children and non-offending family members



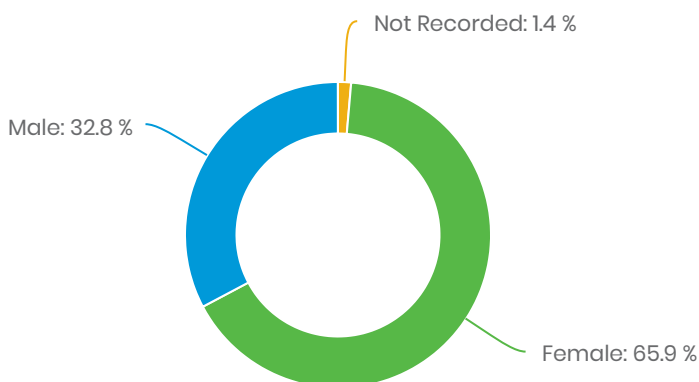
CLIENTS IN EACH PROGRAM
