



PINWHEEL GARDENS

We need Pinwheel Garden SPONSORS and HOSTS!

April is recognized as Child Abuse Prevention Month, and Pinwheels are the national symbol for this critical work across the country.

This year, Dallas Children's Advocacy Center will "plant" Pinwheel Gardens around Dallas County to create awareness and build advocates.

Each garden will include 35 blue pinwheels and an accompanying sign 'planted' in front of a community location. (retail, restaurants, schools, police stations and the like)

We need sponsors to help underwrite these gardens and make this awareness campaign possible, and we need host sites willing to display a garden during the month of April.

Pinwheel Garden Sponsor:

Pinwheel Garden Host Location:

- You tell us how many locations you are willing to host, the address for each, and a contact person.
- Last week of March, we will have volunteers deliver signs and 'plant' the pinwheel garden. If you would like to 'plant' your own garden, we will deliver supplies.
- First full week of May, our volunteers will return to remove the garden, unless you would like to keep the pinwheels.
- Each garden consists of 35 oversize pinwheels, appx 18in high, and an accompanying mission overview and recognition sign on an H-stake frame, similar to a typical yard sign.
